He is currently head of the Spine Surgery Service at Hospital Ortopédico/ Vila da Serra, which is a Service accredited by the Brazilian Spine Society and a reference center in international training AOSpine (Columna Institute/ HVS/ Biocor).

He is part of the editorial board of the journals Coluna/Columna, SciTechnol-Journal of Spine and Neurosurgery, Revista Brasileira de Ortopedia (RBO), International Journal of Spine Surgery and SPINE. Chaired the III Brazilian Congress of Minimally Invasive Surgery of the Spine, held in 2012 in Salvador/BA.

President of the XV Brazilian Spine Congress, which was held in Belo Horizonte/MG, in 2015. He participates as a member of the Scientific Committee of several congresses of International Societies such as SMISS (Society for Minimally Invasive Spine Surgery), ISASS (International Society for Advancements in Spine Surgery), AOSPINE and NASS (North American Spine Society).
